

Turley Guernsey Youth Scholarship Application

Application Deadline—March 31, 2012

Rules:

1. The applicant must:
 - a. own one or more registered Guernseys
 - b. have shown at a National Guernsey Junior Show at least once in the last three years (2009/2010/2011)
 - c. be a graduating high school senior or in college (no older than 21 years of age as of January 1, 2012)
 - d. be a youth member of the American Guernsey Association
2. All entries must be received by the American Guernsey Association, c/o Brian Schnebly, 10111 Melody Lane, Hagerstown, MD 21740 by **March 31, 2012**.
3. One national winner will be selected to receive a \$500 scholarship to be used for college education or technical training. Once a person has won the Turley scholarship, they are ineligible to compete again.
4. The applicant must complete an interview with a panel of three judges, either by phone or in person at the National Guernsey Convention. If you require a phone interview, please contact the AGA as soon as possible so arrangements can be made for the interview.
5. Judging will be based upon the following:
 - a. 80% written application (25% on involvement with Guernseys, 20% on academic performance, 20% on activities and community service, and 15% on the essay)
 - b. 20% interview
