## THE 2025 ALL AMERICAN CONTEST

The All-American Program recognizes the outstanding animals exhibited at State, Regional and National shows during the current calendar year. The option to enter online is available, as well as submission of ALL information to the Purebred Publishing office at: 1224 Alton Darby Creek Rd., Columbus, OH 43228

For the 2025 show season, the All-American competition will consist of the following Classes:

Spring Heifer Calf (born on or after 3/1/25 and is 4 months of age) Winter Heifer Calf (born 12/1/24 thru 2/28/25) Fall Heifer Calf (born 9/1/24 thru 11/30/24) Summer Yearling Heifer (born 6/1/24 thru 8/31/24) Spring Yearling Heifer (born 3/1/24 thru 5/31/24) Winter Yearling Heifer (born 12/1/23 thru 2/29/24) Fall Yearling Heifer (born 9/1/23 thru 11/30/23)\*

\*Animals that have qualified in both the Fall Yearling and Yearling in Milk classes during 2025 may enter both by submitting two separate entries, fees AND qualifying photos

7,700CFP Lifetime on official DHIA test) ELIGIBILITY-To be entered in the All-American contest, an animal must be

a Registered Guernsey and have shown at any Guernsey show in the United States that sends in official results to Purebred Publishing.

ENTRIES - Entries can be made online or sent in by the owner. Entries can be made online at usguernsey.com/all-american. Online entries must be paid at that time with credit card. A fee of \$35 per entry (each animal or group) is required if made online or postmarked on or before November 15 or late entry fee (\$70) if postmarked by November 22. Those animals submitted for Junior All-American will automatically be considered for All-American competition at no extra charge. The owner will receive a complimentary AGA Performance Pedigree for each animal that is All-American, Reserve All-American or Honorable Mention in their respective class. Make checks payable to Purebred Publishing. If the fee does not accompany the entry, it will not be accepted.

The exhibitor must submit a completed entry form and of each entry to the AGA by November 15, 2025 or (by November 22 at late entry fee) to qualify for the contest. Postmark date determines qualification. All regional, state and national show placings should be included on the entry form by the exhibitor or the animal will be disqualified. For group classes, list only those shows at which that EXACT group was shown. FAILURE TO LIST ALL PLACINGS AT NATIONAL SHOWS WILL AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFY THE ANIMAL(S) AND ENTRY WILL BE FORFEITED. FAILURE TO CORRECTLY LIST ALL OTHER MAJOR SHOWS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFCATION. For consistency, please use the National show titles in show placing. NGS/NJS-Harrisburg; NGS/ NJS-Madison; NGS/NJS-Lousville; NGS/NJS-Lynden.

ENTRIES MUST BE AT PUREBRED PUBLISHING BY NOVEMBER 15, 2025. PICTURES - It shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor to secure and supply the pictures of the animals being entered in the All-American contest. It is encouraged that ALL photos be submitted electronically either from

the professional photogropher or owner to

allamericanentry@gmail.com. PICTURES MUST BE RECEIVED BY PUREBRED PUBLISHING BY NOVEMBER 22.

If hard copy submitted, each picture must be 5 x 7 professional livestock unretouched color glossy print. ON THE BACK MUST BE NAME, REGISTRA-TION NUMBER AND DATE TAKEN. Pictures must be taken during the curProduce of Dam (Group to consist of two females, any age, that are maternal sisters.)

Jr. Best Three Females (Group to consist of three females born on or after September 1, 2023 which have not yet calved. Each must have been bred, all or in part, by its exhibitor and at least two must be owned, all or in part, by its exhibitor)

Sr. Best Three Females (Group to consist of three females, two milking age, one any age, all to have been bred, all or in part, by their exhibitor and at least two must be owned, all or in part, by their exhibitor) Exhibitor's Herd (Group of five females to consist of two of any age that have calved at least once; two born on or after September 1, 2023 which have not yet calved; and one of any age. Three of these females must have been bred, all or in part, by the exhibitor. All must be owned, all or in part, by the exhibitor.)

Note: A cow qualifying in a dry cow class is eligible for competition in her respective standard class providing the picture represents her in the same show ring condition as when she qualified.

Note: If an eligible show does not have a specific individual animal class listed above (eg. Yearling in Milk, Summer Jr. Two-Year-Old, etc), enter animal in appropriate age class and list placing specifying in which class she was exhibited.

rent year and show the animal in the same stage of growth and/or lactation as when making the qualifying show ring appearance. Pictures will remain in the Purebred Publishing and AGA office files after the contest and become the permanent property of the AGA for any promotional purposes. For competition in the group classes, an individual picture of each animal in the group must be submitted. The pictures must be of the animals which are shown when the group qualified for entry. If substitutions are made in a group from one show to the next, different entries must be made for each qualifying combination.

All applicants must be in good standing with both Purebred Publishing and AGA. Any accounts 90 days or more past due will be ineligible until balance is paid in full or payment arrangements are established with each entity.

THE CONTEST - A committee of the four judges of the National Guernsey shows will select the six top entries in each class as All-American nominees. The selection committee that chooses the All-American winners will consist of judges from state, regional, and national shows that have had results submitted by state/show secretaries to Purebred Publishing, and at least one animal exhibited at their respective show has been entered in the contest. Pictures and placings of the six nominees in each class will be sent to each selection committee member. The judges will vote individually electronically, giving first, second and third choices in each class. Judges are prohibited from ranking classes in which they have bred, own, or have other interest in any animal(s) entered. Each first-place vote shall count five points, second place shall count three points and third place shall count one point. AGA staff will determine the awards by simple arithmetic. The class entries receiving the highest number of points shall be named All-American, those receiving the second-highest point total shall be designated Reserve All-American, and those with the third-highest total will be designated Honorable Mention. In case of a tie, the entry with the most All-American votes will receive the higher honor. If a tie still remains, the animal with the most Reserve All-American votes will receive the higher position. If the entries have the exact same vote point breakdown, then the nominees tie for the highest honor in question. The nominations and winners will appear in the Spring 2026 Guernsey Breeders' Journal and will be published on usguernsey.com.

## L AMERICAN CONTEST

Eligibility-AGA junior members born from January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2016 may enter the Junior All-American Contest. The animal entered must be a Registered Guernsey that has placed in the top six of its class at any junior show in the United States in 2025 that has submitted placings to the office. The ownership of the entry or qualifying lease form shall be recorded solely in the name of AGA junior member(s) by August 1, 2025

Classes-The classes will be the same as all individual heifer, yearling

Classes-I he classes will be the same as all individual heiter, yearling and cow classes in the All-American Contest.

Entry Fee-A fee of \$35 per entry is required if postmarked on or before November 15 or late entry fee (\$70) if postmarked November 22.

Those animals entered for Junior All-American will automatically be considered for All-American competition at no extra charge. The owner will receive a complimentary AGA Performance Pedigree for each animal that is named All-American, Reserve All-American and Honorable Mention in their respective class tion in their respective class.

Entries-Entry forms may be obtained from the AGA web site and/or entered online at www.usguernsey.com. The junior must submit a completed entry form and one photograph of each entry to the AGA by November 15, 2025 to qualify for the contest. All national, state and regional show placings should be recorded on the entry form by the junior or the entry will be disqualified. A photo by a professional livestock photographer must be taken of the animal during the 2025 calendar year and should represent the animal in a stage of development as nearly comparable to show ring appearance as possible. Five by seven-inch, glossy, color pictures are required (electronic prefered). Unaltered, professional livestock photographer pictures are required. All other pictures are unacceptable and the entry will be disqualified. Contestant is responsible for having one photo forwarded to the AGA. A junior entry in both open & junior contests should carry the same exhibitor name except in the case of leased animals.

Judging-The judging will be handled in the same manner as the All-American Contest, except the judging panel will be composed of those judging qualifying Junior Shows submitted to the AGA by November 1. Entries-Entry forms may be obtained from the AGA web site and/or en-
